

Cascade Friends Camp 2010

August 15th through August 20th

THEME:

THE WAY OF CHRIST

PURPOSE:

Cascade Friends' camp is for young people ages 9 through 18, or who have completed grades 3 through 12; and our goal is to provide them a pure, wholesome and beneficial environment for campers, where they can meet and associate with others of like precious faith, learn bible principles, and grow in love for God and each other.

LOCATION:

Our camp is held at the *Lazy F Camp and Retreat Center*, located on 110 acres of mixed forest in the heart of the Manastash Canyon in the Eastern Cascade Mountain Foothills near Ellensburg, Washington. You may look at their facility online at: <http://www.lazyfcamp.org/>.

ACTIVITIES:

Each day begins with camp devotionals, and concludes with a singing. We will exercise our spirits in song, prayer, and bible study, while we exercise our bodies with numerous character building team sports. Three wholesome and tasty meals will be provided daily at the Lazy F Dining Hall, with snacks also available. Crafts will be available for those who wish to create a memory. Lazy F certified safety personnel will be supervising The Climbing Tower and The Zip Line. FUN! While The Climbing Tower is available for all Junior and Senior Campers, The Zip Line is only suitable for campers at least in the 5th Grade.

FEES:

Please calculate your fees due on the *CAMPER REGISTRATION* form.

- \$50 - Advance Deposit by May 14th, 2010 *recommended* (not mandatory), included with *CAMPER REGISTRATION* form to guarantee a place at camp.
- \$265 - Registration Fee if payment is received in full by Registration Discount Deadline June 18th, 2010.
- \$275 - Registration Fee if final payment is completed anytime after Discount Deadline, June 18th, 2010, and before the Registration Final Deadline July 16th, 2010.
- \$15 - OPTIONAL Camp T-Shirt, must be pre-ordered on *CAMPER REGISTRATION* form.
- \$10 to \$20 - OPTIONAL Canteen deposit. Beverages and snacks will be available daily at the Canteen. If you would like your camper to take advantage of this, then you may deposit funds into your camper's personal canteen account. Balances will be reconciled upon check-out.

DEADLINES:

The Registration Final Deadline date is July 16th, 2010. The balance of your Registration, T-Shirt, and Canteen fees are due by that date. Also, the *CAMPER REGISTRATION*, *TRANSPORTATION RELEASE*, *MEDICAL RELEASE*, and *CASCADE FRIENDS HOLD HARMLESS WAIVER CAMP RULES AGREEMENT* forms are all due by the July 16th, 2010 Registration Final Deadline date. For staff members - Disclosure Statements are due immediately (unless you have submitted one before).

Arrival/Departure Times:

Check-In and Check-Out:

- Check-In begins at 4:00 PM, Sunday, August 15th at the Lazy F campground.
- Check-Out will be from 11:00 AM until 12:15 PM, Friday, August 20th.
- Check-Out can be completed **only** through the Cascade Friends Registrar. The camper may be released **only** to the person listed on the camper's Transportation Release form.

- ***NO EARLY CHECK-INS***
- ***NO EARLY CHECK-OUTS***

What to Bring:

Campers should bring a Bible, pens & pencils, a sleeping bag, pillow, extra blanket, warm clothes to sleep in, a flashlight with extra batteries, bug spray (10% to 30% Deet), sunscreen, hiking shoes, modest swimsuit with cover-up for going to and from the lake, towels, toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste/brush, etc.), garbage bags for dirty clothes and a backpack for hiking. Flip flops and sandals will not be allowed while participating in the daily activities, so please make sure to bring footwear that will fully cover your feet.

Our goal is to enjoy God's creation and our fellowship together. All electronic devices are discouraged; and while **cell phones are not allowed**, our staff will ensure that every camper can contact their parents at any time.

We welcome any poster that a camper might like to bring to camp that reflects this year's theme.
